Eligibility

- 1. Undergraduate students who have completed at least one year of academic study at your university.
- 2. Have a good academic standing.
- 3. Be proficient in English. If English is not your first language you must provide evidence of your language ability when you apply:

College of International Relations

TOEFL® PBT test 540, TOEFL® iBT test 76, IELTS Academic 6.0, TOEIC® L&R test 740 or equivalent

College of Policy Science

TOEFL® PBT test 460, TOEFL® iBT test 50, IELTS Academic 5.0, TOEIC® L&R test 580 or equivalent

Note: If you wish to take Business Track courses, you will be expected to have a good command of English (TOEFL® PBT test 520, TOEFL® iBT test 68 or equivalent).

Benefits

Students under an Agreement for Student Exchange with one of our partner universities receive the following benefits:

- 1. Tuition Waiver. The tuition is waived for students from partner institutions.
- 2. Scholarship: Eligible to apply for the JASSO scholarship. A monthly stipend of 80,000 yen is offered for a period of 4 months.

This scholarship is offered by the Japan Student Services Organization (JASSO).

Applicants are screened by Ritsumeikan.
