Virtual Exchange – Important Considerations	<ul> <li>As your exchange program is conducted online only, we will not issue a Confirmation of Enrolment for Visa purposes.</li> <li>You can select to study between 1 to 4 units during your virtual exchange program.</li> <li>You can only select units that are only offered fully online – this includes both lectures and tutorials.</li> <li>You may be required to attend live classes or tutorials, so we advise you check the time difference between your home country and Australia when selecting your units.</li> </ul>

While selecting the units, you must consider the following:  - Units are available in the enrolled semester (Session 1 = February to July)  - Suitable to the students' level of study (UG = Undergraduate and PG = Postgraduate).  Undergraduate level = 1000 level (1st year)  Undergraduate level = 2000 level (2nd year)  Undergraduate level = 3000 level (3rd year)  Postgraduate level = 8000 and 9000 level  You have met the academic prerequisites or equivalent at your University.
