B. Eligibility Requirements

- Language Proficiency Requirement : Not required
- Minimum one semester's study at home University

C. Required Documents

- * Any documents in a language other than Korean or English must be accompanied by a Korean or English translation.
 - 1) Completed Application Form
 - 2) Completed Self-Introduction
 - 3) Completed Study Plan
 - 4) Upload a Certificate of Enrollment from Currently Enrolled University
 - 5) Upload a Letter of Recommendation from an Academic Source
 - 6) Upload Original Sealed Transcript from Currently Enrolled University
 - 7) Upload a Copy of the Passport Information Page
 - 8) Upload ID Photo(background must be white)

Dormitory

A. CHAMBIT HALL

- 1) Fee : Approximately KRW 1,062,360 per semester
- 2) Meals : Provide three meals a day in dormitory cafeteria except all weekends. It is not allowed to cook at dormitory.
- 3) Facilities
 - Two persons in a room
 - Each room is furnished with a desk, a chair, an air conditioner, a bed, a wardrobe, and bathroom.
- B. Dormitory fees must be transferred to university's bank account before you arrive at Korea.
 - After you transfer the dormitory fee, the applicant's English name will be written the receipt. Please, scan or copy the receipt and send it to the coordinator via email.
 - Specific details about the payment dates and account information will be notified via email.
- C. Dormitory fees include water and electricity.

Insurance

A. Insurance fee : KRW 110,000 per year, KRW 60,000 per six months

- B. Insurance Coverage
 - Regular treatment, medicine, surgery and hospitalization at a hospital
 - Dental and a cosmetic procedure are not covered by insurance
 - Accident caused by driving a car or motorcycle are not covered by insurance.
- C. Although students might already have an insurance from their country, they have to get an insurance recommended by JBNU as well.
