Consent Agreement (Inbound Student Exchange Program)

Due to the current COVID-19 situation, Chulalongkorn University is concerned about the welfare and safety of all students. For those who wish to take part in the Student Exchange program at Chulalongkorn University either for one semester, in the Spring semester (January – May 2022), or for one academic year, from the Spring semester (January – May 2022) to the Fall semester (August – December 2022), please read the information below and provide your signature as a proof of acknowledgement before traveling to Thailand.

In the event where there is a risk or suspicion of being infected with COVID-19, students must notify, with evidence, the Dean of the host Faculty/Institute/School for an arrangement for quarantine—a period when they will be restricted from attending classes, taking exams, conducting activities or working on the University campus.

In cases where they are infected with COVID-19, students must notify the Dean of the host Faculty/Institute/School and must inform their home university's coordinator or responsible personnel of their situation, and cooperate with local public health officials by providing them with the timeline of their activities before and during the time of infection and any other information needed for monitoring the virus.

Before traveling to Thailand, all foreign students must receive COVID -19 vaccine in accordance with the health requirements of their country. Moreover, they are required to purchase travel insurance covering all expenses for medical care and treatment, including the treatment of COVID-19 and the validity of this insurance must include the period of their stay in Thailand before the semester starts. This is because all foreign students are required to purchase Chula Group Health Insurance whose coverage is from January 1 to July 31, 2022.

It is important that all exchange students strictly comply with disease preventive measures as well as rules and regulations prescribed by the Thai Government and Chulalongkorn University; more information can be found on CHULA COVID-19 webpage via: https://www.chula.ac.th/en/covid-19/
