## Number of Acceptable Exchange Students

We generally have received 1-2 students for one academic year (1 student for 1 academic year is equivalent to 2 students for 1 semester). However, as it can be changed considering its balance and inquiry, it would be necessary to be discussed between two universities if there are more students who would like to study.

## Required documents for application

#### Online submission

- 3.5cm \* 4.5cm color photo of face (front view on white background only)
- Photocopy of passport
- Academic transcript in English
- Letter of recommendation
- Completed Medical Form
- Agreement on Personal Information
- Other certificates such as language, activities, etc. (If applicable)

Note: After the period of official nomination, partners and students will receive information about the online application process by email.

### **Visa Process**

- All documents will be sent to the university that nominated the students
- Each student must submit documents listed below to the Korean Embassy in one's country.
- a. Valid Passport
- b. Certificate of admission
- c. Business registration of the host university
- d. Completed visa application form
- e. Recent certificate of school record
- f. Verification of account balance
- g. Visa processing fee

English language proficiency	At intermediate/high level to take English-based courses - Certificates (e.g., TOEFL / IELTS) are not required.
Tuberculosis Test	Optional for students who stay in dormitory  - Students may take the test before they come to Korea (within 1 month before at least) if they will stay in dormitory  - Otherwise, they can take the test at the beginning of semester in the host university
Health Insurance	Mandatory - International students must have national insurance of the Republic of Korea due to changed health insurance policy(about 40\$ every month)
Housing	Dormitory application:  - Students should apply for dormitory when they register the online application form.  - Students are requested to pay for the dormitory fee at the designated bank during the payment period after students enter the dormitory room.  Prices (As of Fall Semester 2021)  * Affected by COVID-19  - General Hall (2 persons / Room)  a. With two meals a day: KRW 1,415,000  b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,057,000  c. Without meal: KRW 593,000  Prices and conditions of the dormitory are subject to change by semester  * Dormitory fee should be paid by cash or transferred to assigned bank account in Korea (money transfer from abroad or credit card are not available)
