ENROLMENT

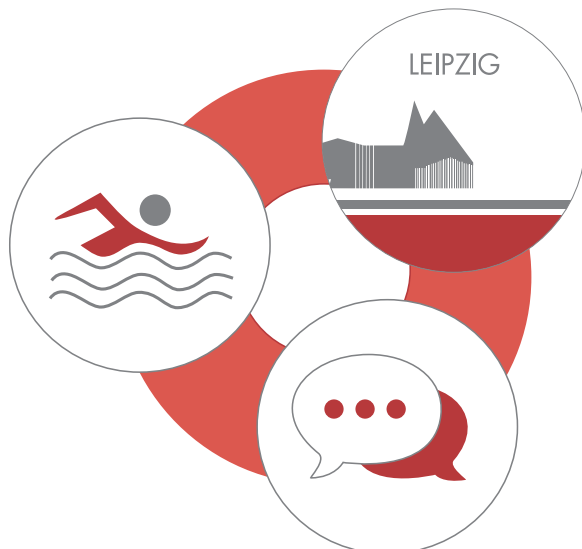
Enrolment for **participants of the language and orientation course** takes place three weeks before the regular start of the semester (approx. mid-March resp. mid-September).
