STUDENT ACCOMMODATION

As a fully residential university, the university provides lodging for more than 20,000 students in 15 different residential halls.

In campus, students have two options:

1. Residential Hall - Single room and twin-sharing room, common bathroom, cafeteria, laundry room, sport facility, study room, pantry and groceries store. Rental is RM570 per semester.
2. Universiti Inn - One-bedroom type apartment with air-condition. Monthly rental is RM1,200 per unit and can accommodate maximum two persons.

Among the facilities provided at each residential college are cafeterias, multipurpose hall, muslim prayer room, study room, internet, convenient store and common room. All international students are guaranteed a room on campus.

Students who want spacious room and modern amenities with the comfort of a 3- star hotel can choose to stay at EDC Hotel. It is located 4 km away from UUM Sintok campus. EDC hotel offers a room rate of RM2,500 per month for long-term stay guest. The room can accommodate two persons.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

The University Shuttle Service operates bus service from 8:00 am - 6:00 pm throughout the academic year (except during public holiday) providing safe, convenient transportation throughout the UUM Sintok Campus.

COST ESTIMATION

Tuition fees

Students from non-partner universities need to pay full tuition fees with estimation of MYR 2,750 - MYR 5,000 per semester.

Exchange students from partner universities are eligible for tuition fees exemption.

LIVING EXPENSES

Living in Malaysia very affordable. The overall expenses of living in campus for a single student are estimated between MYR1,000.00 - MYR1,500.00 per person per month (USD250-USD375). This includes room, books, food, personal expenditures and travel within the state of Kedah. The total cost varies depending on personal requirement and lifestyle.

HEALTH INSURANCE

International students are required to obtain insurance coverage while studying in Malaysia.

It is compulsory to purchase insurance from the EMGS system while applying for Visa Approval Letter (e-VAL).

VISA REQUIREMENTS

All international students are required to have a valid Student Pass (Visa) to study in Malaysia. You can start applying for a Student Pass (Visa) after you have the offer letter from UUM. Please initiate your student pass application as early as 4 months but no later than 2 months before your course commencement date.

All applications are lodged through the Education Malaysia Global Services (EMGS) portal

(<https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/>). Please ensure that you have prepared the following softcopy documents for your student pass application:

- Offer Letter from Universiti Utara Malaysia (UUM).
- Passport size photograph with WHITE background (35mm x 45mm). Use the online photo checker to confirm that your photo meets the requirements.
- Passport data page on a single-sided A4 paper without enlargement or reduction. Centre each double page of the passport on the paper.
- Latest academic transcript from your home institution
- Letter of confirmation of enrolment by your home institution
- Health declaration form

The Immigration Department of Malaysia will issue a Visa Approval Letter (VAL) once your application is approved.

HOW TO APPLY?

1. Fill in the application form. Please get the application form from www.ciac.uum.edu.my
2. Supporting documents:
 - Copy of academic transcript
 - Letter from your university /faculty about your English Language competency level.
 - Nomination letter from your university (home university)
 - Passport photo size (4.5 cm x 5.0 cm)
 - Passport information page or Student ID Card
3. Submit the completed document to your university International Office (home university).
4. Home university International Office will nominate students for mobility programme by submitting the application to UUM (host university) at global.mobility@uum.edu.my
5. You will receive an offer of admission letter if your application for study at UUM is successful. CIAC will send the offer letter to your university International Office.
