◆ Eligibility requirements

Students who are enrolled in our partner universities, ISEP Exchange or UMAP Program A universities and were nominated by the home institution.

- ▶ Students whose G.P.A. is 2.5/4.0 or higher 【Partner U/UMAP】, 3.0/4.0 or higher 【ISEP】.
- ▶ Students who have a Japanese Language Proficiency Test (JLPT) score of N3 or higher or the equivalent of CEFR B2 or higher in English or who come from a university where the language of instruction is Japanese or English.

TOEIC L&R+TOEIC S&W	1530 or higher *Please calculate as follows. Formula: TOEIC L&R score+(TOEIC S&W score*2.5) e.g. TOEIC L&R 800, TOEIC S&W 300 →800+(300*2.5)=1550

*Students who don't have a Japanese or English language proficiency test score are required to submit an "English-Language Ability Certificate". Students can access the certificate on our website and Toyo Net-ACE.

*If your home university offers courses mostly in English, you don't need to submit proof of your English language ability.

◆Study period

Changing the length of your period of study after submitting your application documents (from a semester to a year, or a year to a semester) is not allowed. Please decide your desired length of study before submitting your application.

◆Important note

If self-isolation for a period of time after entering Japan is required due to the continued spread of the novel coronavirus, you will need to bear the cost of the accommodations during your self-isolation.

If you have special learning needs, please inform the International Affairs Office when you apply. We will determine what kind of support we will be able to provide.

Step 2: The guidelines for submitting documents through our web system, Toyo Net-ACE, will be sent to exchange program coordinators (students from partner universities and UMAP) or students (students from ISEP) after the deadline of the online application (around March 10). Please note that the online application is just a part of the application process and students need to submit other application documents through our web system. If you do not submit the application documents by the deadline, we will take that to mean that you have declined the placement and withdrawn your application.
