The Virtual Mobility Programme makes education accessible by allowing students to take professional courses and participate in co-curricular programs without the need to leave home. In addition to the professional courses, students will be exposed to the cross cultural experience, which has been the signature of INTI's Student Mobility Programme. This combination of online learning and virtual exchange will provide students with a unique intercultural experience through digital technologies and platforms.

List of Workshops

Communicating Your Personal Brand (Duration : 2 Hours)

Personal Brand has become an important element in the building of one's identity in this fast paced world. The ability to be, speak and write with your brand in mind is a powerful tool to stand out in the current market.By the end of this workshop, participants will be trained in the art of communicating strategically via a range of tools for a consistent brand identity.

Workshop: How to write a Good Blog-Post to boost sales? (Duration: 2 Hours)

The first half of the session, students will learn the theoretical parts (the format, style, arrangement of wordings and so on) while in second half of the session is to let students learn how to produce the blog-post or designing the e-posters, with online free software.

Latest Construction Technology (Duration: 1 Hour) This workshop presents the technologies in land surveying, building construction, road construction and also tunnelling operations for infrastructure works. This includes the evaluation stage of the road construction, adopting laser, video imaging, GPS testing. The workshop also highlights the latest construction technologies including road recycling, virtual site exploration, drone in monitoring construction works, the application of Virtual Reality and BIM.

Design & construct (Duration: 2 Hours)

Egg drop parachute challenge - students will design and construct a parachute of restricted size, which will keep a raw, grade A, large egg from breaking or cracking. (LO: To describe the basics of physics concept and application in real life).

Contemporay Malay and Indian Dance (Duration: 2 Hours)

Students will be introduced the contemporary Malay and Indian dance in a modern environment yet will hold on to the authenticity of the original pieces. It is believed that the duty of the dancer is to create an atmosphere of peace through the art form. **Create Animation with Alice (Duration : 2 Hours)** This workshop provides step-by-step directions for guiding students through designing and implementing a simple animation using Alice software.

Critical Thinking (Duration: 2 Hours)

These workshops are primarily designed to help students develop their thinking skills which include both critical and creative thinking skills. Students would be exposed to real life situations which would require them to use a variety of thinking tools to innovate products or solve problems such as Six Thinking Hats, SWOT Analysis and SCAMPER. At the end of the workshop, the student will be able to Construct and present clear, coherent, and logical arguments orally and in writing, to solve real life problems situations by using appropriate tools and techniques, design and invent a product using the problem-solving tools learnt in this cours and to defend their own ideas and effectively critique their friends' ideas in each situation.

No limit of students from a partner university.


Requirement Documents
