## Micro-credential Course (MCC) 1 - How to Produce a High-Quality Paper for Journal

Topics	Delivery Model	Synopsis of the Topic
Things to know before your first paper publication	2 hours online session	The importance of publication to academician, an introduction to know how to identify the journals, indexers of the journals, the synergy of joint publications, the importance of joining conferences are highlighted.
Prepare an attractive research article according to the format of the journal Prepare an attractive research article according to the format of the journal	2 hours online session	Abstracts, Introduction, Methodology, Results and Discussion, Conclusions.
Prepare an interesting review paper for journal publication	2 hours online session	Discuss a topic systematically, how to write literature review and background, collection of information, presentation of the topic according to different sections, with synthesis and evaluation of the topic.
Prepare a high-quality paper for journal publication	2 hours online session	Selection of data, novelty and contribution to the society, the format of the paper, language usage, recent literature and time relevant of the research, and recommendation from the authors.
How to identify the index and determine the quality of the journals	2 hours online session	How to use information from Scopus and WoS websites. The information on quartile (Q1 to Q4), Journal Citation Report (JCR), Impact Factor, Cite Score, citation per journal paper to measure the quality of a journal.
Provide effective responses to the comments by reviewers and editors	2 hours online session	Revision process is important. General template and information required for the responses, rebuttal letter, improvement, way to communicate with editors, track of the changes, and how to perform language checking will be highlighted.

Topics	Delivery Model	Synopsis of the Topic
Design a simple research and data collection strategy for publication	2 hours online session	Set simple objectives, identification of novelty, design of survey and questionnaire, data collection from students, design of assignment or coursework, strategy of student laboratory works.
Develop a good research proposal	2 hours online session	Title, objectives, novelty and contribution to knowledge and society, clear research methods and data analysis, set realistic milestones, expected results, and support from international collaborators.
Ethics in research and publication	2 hours online session	Authorship, plagiarism, submission to a single journal at a time, student's work, pilot study, human or animal as subject of studies, declaration on questionnaire, etc.
