Courses / English Language Proficiency	<ul> <li>Exchange students typically enroll in the courses offered in English. Therefore, an intermediate/high level of English proficiency is required to take these courses.</li> <li>Certificates (e.g., TOEFL / IELTS) are not required.</li> <li>Students may choose to register for the courses offered in Korean. However, an intermediate/high level of Korean proficiency is required to take these courses.</li> </ul>
Alien Registration	<ul> <li>All international students must apply for the alien registration card (ARC), which is mandatory in Korea, upon arrival.</li> <li>Students cannot apply for the registration on their own, as the immigration office does not accept individual applications. The application can only be submitted through the university.</li> </ul>
Health Insurance	Compulsory  - All international students are required to have national insurance from the Republic of Korea (approximately \$70 per month). They will be automatically enrolled when they apply for their alien registration card.  Optional  - Students may individually purchase traveler's insurance.
Housing	<ul> <li>Dormitory application</li> <li>Students can apply for a dormitory when submitting the online application form.</li> <li>All students are guaranteed campus housing if they apply during the online application period.</li> <li>Dormitory Fee (As of Spring Semester 2024)</li> <li>General Hall (2 persons/room)</li> <li>a. With two meals a day: KRW 1,501,000</li> <li>b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,116,000</li> <li>c. Without meal: KRW 636,000</li> </ul>

Bongsa (male only) / Hyupruk Hall (female only)(2 persons/room)

a. With two meals a day: KRW 2,103,000b. With one meal a day: KRW 1,718,000

c. Without meal: KRW 1,238,000

- <u>Please note that the above information is for reference only,</u> and dormitory fees may vary each semester.
