ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to study at UC on Exchange, applicants must:

- Have successfully completed at least one year of full-timeequivalent study at their home institution.
- ✓ Have at least an average grade point average of 4.5 on a 7-point scale.
- Enrol for full-time study at UC, i.e., 12 credit points, or four units/subjects, per semester.
- Meet all UC entry requirements, including English language requirements outlined below.
