Application for the “Certificate of Eligibility” (CoE)

Applicants are required to apply for the CoE via online system to obtain the Japanese visa. The URL for this Online Application System will be sent to you by email from Kobe Univ (intl-cesr@office.kobe-u.ac.jp) **around mid-May. The deadline for submission will be announced at that time.**

At the time of sending your Exchange Program Application Form, you do **NOT** need to submit the application for the CoE to us (You will need to complete the online application form after the **mid-May**.) But please submit the Digital ID Photo and Proof of Financial Support by April 30 as we will check these documents in advance.

3. Proof of Financial Support (Must be translated into English)

Documents that prove that you have sufficient financial support to pay for your expenses while studying at Kobe University (Question 22 on the Online Application Form for CoE).

(1) If you choose “Self”

- The latest bank statement for the applicant’s own account (Closing balance must be more than 600,000 JPY for a 1 semester stay / more than 1,200,000 JPY for a 1 year stay.)

(2) If you choose “Supporter living outside of Japan” or “Supporter in Japan”

Both of the following documents are necessary:

- The latest bank statement for the financial supporter’s account (Closing balance must be more than 600,000 JPY for a 1 semester stay / more than 1,200,000 JPY for a 1 year stay.)
- A certificate of employment and annual income for the financial supporter.

(3) If you choose “Scholarship”

- A copy of an official document proving that the applicant will receive the scholarship/ grant

Student Visa Obligations	Undergraduate Students: Must take more than 10 hours of lecture which equals to 6 classes per week. Graduate Students (Master/Doctor): Must have more than 10 hours of research hours including at least 1 class per week.
Japanese Language Course	The Global Education Center (GEC) offers Japanese language courses for exchange students. Students who wish to take these courses are required to take the online level check test prior to the semester. http://www.kisc.kobe-u.ac.jp/english/leaning_japanese/ <Non-credit bearing courses> 1. Integrated Japanese Course: open to all exchange students. 2. Intensive Japanese Course: developed for MEXT (Japanese government) scholarship students. Exchange students can be enrolled in this course on an availability basis only. <Credit bearing course> 3. Japanese Language and Japanese Studies Course: (advanced level) for undergraduate students only.

VISA	In order to support international students' smooth admission into Kobe University, we offer prospective students a proxy application service for their Certificate of Eligibility (COE). Once we have confirmed the online CoE application with the correct information and the official acceptance to Kobe University has been approved, your VISA judging procedures will be proceeded by the Immigration Bureau of Japan. We will forward the email on behalf of the Immigration Bureau of Japan to students regarding the result of the VISA application once we have it, and <u>students MUST print it out and go to the Japanese Embassy or Consulate in home country to activate their VISA before entering Japan.</u>	

Entry to Japan	It is strongly advised to enter Japan via Narita, Haneda, Chubu, or Kansai International Airports in order to have your Residence Card issued by the Immigration Bureau of Japan upon your arrival.
Airport Pick up	No pick-up service is arranged by Kobe University. Please note that exchange students are fully responsible for arranging accommodation on the arrival day if you cannot enter the dormitory on the same day.
Insurance	<p>All exchange students are required to buy the following insurance services to cover financial cost in case of sickness/injuries and/or accidents during your stay in Japan. The detailed information will be provided at the Orientation.</p> <p>National Health Insurance: The Ministry of Health, Labor, and Welfare in Japan now requires all College Student Visa holders to become a registered member of the Japan National Health Insurance. All exchange students must enroll in it. Students will pay monthly premiums (Approximately 2,400 JPY per month). Upon joining this system, students will be charged only 30% of the incurred medical cost.</p> <p>Kobe University PAS : PAS (Personal Accident Insurance for Students Pursing Education and Research) is a nationwide system to indemnify students for the number of days that medical treatment is needed for injury incurred during regular curricular activities and while commuting to or from University (1,000JPY up to 1 year). All students are required to participate in this insurance plan.</p> <p>Comprehensive Insurance for Students Lives Couples with PAS for International Students (Inbound Futai Gakusou) This insurance offers expanded coverage for international students. Kobe University requires all international students to sign up for this comprehensive insurance at the time of enrollment.</p> <p>Inbound Medical Assistance Service (IMAS) IMAS provides international students with 24 hours multilingual medical assistance including references to appropriate hospitals, telephone consultations, interpretation during hospital visits, as well as contacting and assisting family in your home country. Kobe University requires all international students to sign up for this service.</p>
