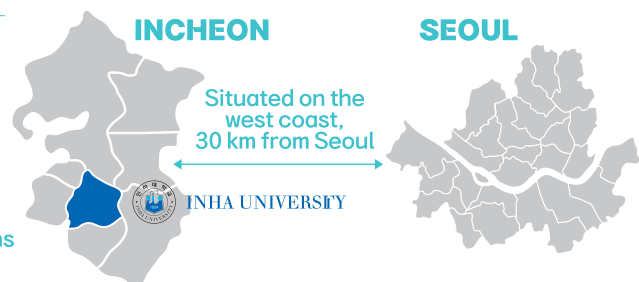
The city is evolving into a global business hub, with Songdo New Town at its center—a high-tech, futuristic district designed to host diverse international businesses and trade.

— Chinatown, scenic piers, neighboring islands, shopping malls, museums, movie complexes, beautiful parks and cultural attractions

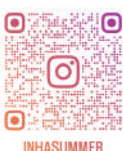

PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The Inha University Summer School provides students with the opportunity to earn academic credits while immersing themselves in Korean culture. This three-week program includes engaging coursework, cultural field trips, and unique experiences that highlight both traditional and modern aspects of Korea.

Since 2004, Inha University has been at the forefront of global education with its annual summer school program. Evolving each year, the program now offers a dynamic short-term, intensive experience that combines classroom lectures, site visits, cultural excursions, and hands-on activities. Participants will gain insights into the dynamic aspects of Korean society—past, present, and future—while earning academic credits and receiving certificates of completion upon concluding the program.

Additionally, students will have numerous opportunities to interact with Korean assistant students and engage with fellow international students. The program is designed to foster meaningful cultural exchanges by allowing participants to share their experiences and perspectives through courses, excursions, and various activities outside the classroom.
