

# **Course Options**

# **Refund Policy**

Please be advised that all refund requests must be submitted in writing to our Seoul International Summer School team. The registration fee is non-refundable. Refunds will be processed within 3-4 weeks of receipt of a valid request.

For tuition refunds, the following policies apply:

- If a student withdraws by June 25, 2025, which is one week prior to the start of the program, the tuition will be refunded less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- 50% of the tuition fee will be refundable before the start of the program, less any commission fees or bank transaction charges.
- From the official start of the program, no refund will be available.
- · A written notice of withdrawal must be made to the office before the deadlines in order to receive the refund. If a student does not appear in class during the first week, the student's admission will be canceled and no refunds will be issued.
