

WHAT IS SYLFF SCHOLARSHIP?

The Ryoichi Sasakawa Young Leaders
Fellowship Fund, or Sylff, is a fellowship
program initiated in 1987 to support
students pursuing graduate studies in the
humanities and social sciences. To date,
endowments of \$1 million each have been
presented to 69 universities and consortia in
44 countries.

The Sylff program aims to identify and nurture leaders who will overcome differences in nationality, language, ethnicity, religion, and political systems to tackle global issues, and whose high integrity and drive to address issues unique to their respective countries can make a real difference. About 17,000 students have received fellowships since the program's launch, and many of these Sylff fellows have gone on to become leaders in a variety of fields following graduation.

WHAT IS SYLFF SCHOLARSHIP?

Fellowships are awarded to outstanding graduate & postgraduate students who are enrolled in degree programs with high potential for leadership at the local, national, regional, and international levels in their private and public lives.

The scope of the fellowships must fall within the parameters of **the social sciences or** humanities.

Recognizing the growing tendency toward inter- and multi-disciplinary approaches, though, students will be eligible for Sylff fellowships if they approach multi-disciplinary research themes from a social science or humanities perspective.

Since 2005, **54 UGM SYLFF fellows (5 PhD programme and 49 Master Programme)** have been awarded the Sylff Scholarships program.

- 3. Master holder with honor (GPA 3.50 or above of 4.00 scale; or other equivalent grade scale)
- 4. No more than 40 years old
- 5. Outstanding English proficiency proven by TOEFL ITP 500, iBT 90, IELTS 6.0 or equivalent
- 6. Preferably attached to university as lecturer or midcareer professional in higher education institution
