- A photocopy of the Japanese Proficiency Certificate (if obtained)
- 7. Tuberculosis (TB) Clearance Certificate for Japan Pre-Entry Tuberculosis Screening (JPETS)

Documents 3,4, 5 and 7 are required when applying for the Certificate of Eligibility (CoE). We confirm these documents in advance before CoE application period (after mid-November). For the detail of the document requirement, please follow to the section below "Application for the Certificate of Eligibility (CoE)".

# Application for the "Certificate of Eligibility (CoE)"

Applicants are required to apply for the CoE via Online Application System to obtain the Japanese visa. The URL for this Online Application System will be sent to you by email from Kobe University after <u>mid-November</u>. The deadline for submission will be announced at that time.

The necessary materials are as below:

#### 1. Copy of Passport ID Page

The Photocopy should be in its original size and with clear image data.

#### 2. Digital ID Photo (for CoE Application)

The photo must meet all the specifications indicated on the following website.

Submittion Photo Standards Immigration Services Agency (moj.go.jp)

Please provide a different photo from the one on your passport.

## 3. Proof of Financial Support (Must be translated into English)

Documents proving that you have sufficient financial support to pay for your expenses while studying at Kobe University. The bank statement must include the account owner's name information. If you choose:

- (1) Self
  - \*The latest bank statement for the applicant's own account. Closing balance must be more than 600,000 JPY for a 1 semester stay / more than 1,200,000 JPY for a 1 year stay.
- (2) Supporter living outside of Japan or Supporter in Japan
  \*The latest bank statement for the financial supporter's account. Closing balance must be
  more than 600,000 JPY for a 1 semester stay / more than 1,200,000 JPY for a 1 year stay.
- (3) Scholarship

A copy of an official document proving that the applicant will receive the scholarship/grant.

TB Clearance Certificate for Japan Pre-Entry Tuberculosis Screening (JPETS)
 \*Only for nationals of certain countries -Philippines, Nepal, Viet Nam, Indonesia, Myanmar and China

Japan Pre-Entry Tuberculosis Screening (JPETS) is a health Certification program introduced by the Japanese government, stated from June 23,2025. Foreign nationals from certain countries who intend to stay in Japan for a mid-long term must undergo Xray and other necessary tests at a Panel Clinic in their home country before entering Japan.

Applicants are required to obtain the TB Clearance Certificate at a clinic to prove a free of active tuberculosis, and must submit the Certificate when applying for a CoE.

On behalf of the Immigration Bureau of Japan, we will send the CoE application result as an electronic document to applicants. Exchange students must print it and the "Certificate of Enrollment' (入学許可書)" for applying student visa.

You <u>must then visit the Japanese Embassy/Consulate Office in your country of residence to apply for a student visa before entering Japan.</u>

# **Student status and Courses information at Kobe University**

Status of exchange students at Kobe University is "Special Auditing Student 特別聴講学生 (non-degree seeking)" or "Special Research Student 特別研究学生 (non-degree seeking)"

Japanese immigration law requires that international students with Student Visa have to take at least the following hours of courses:

(1) Undergraduate Students

Must take more than 10 hours of lecture which equals to 6 classes per week.

(2) Graduate Students (Master/Doctor)

Must take more than 10 hours of research hours including at least 1 class per week

Courses offered at the Graduate School of Intercultural Studies and the Faculty of Global Human Sciences are mostly taught in Japanese. For courses taught in English, please refer to the timetable where courses are marked with an "E": <a href="Academic Calendar/Course List and Timetable">Academic Calendar/Course List and Timetable</a>

Kindly understand that syllabus have all faculty's information. <u>Basically, you are only allowed to take specific courses from your belonged Faculty/ Graduate School and Japanese Language Course.</u>
Undergraduate students have to choose courses from the Faculty of Global Human Sciences, Graduate students have to choose courses from Graduate School of Intercultural Studies.

# **Course Registration and Academic Record Information**

There is no pre-registration system for the course registration. The way of course registration will be announced at Faculty Orientation.
