

## Participation Requirements

- Minimum number of participants:
- At least 5 students per university
- Total of 10 or more participants for the 1-week program The minimum number of participants required will be 13 if the two-week course is not offered.
- Eligibility: Applicants must be undergraduate or graduate students currently enrolled at an accredited college, university or research institution outside Japan as of Winter School 2026.





#### Notes

- Applications will be accepted only through universities.
- Accommodation will be arranged in a dormitory or an apartment within commuting distance, in principle.
- Participants in the 1-week course cannot select the optional course "Survival Japanese with Cultural Experience" offered in the 2-week program.
